I'M HAPPY TO BE HERE TODAY FOR TWO REASONS:

FIRST - BECAUSE THIS IS THE 80TH GRADUATING CLASS OF A GREAT HIGH SCHOOL AND YOU ARE AN EXAMPLE OF THE KIND OF EXCELLENCE LEON HIGH SCHOOL HAS TRADITIONALLY PRODUCED.

SECOND - BECAUSE MY DAUGHTER, KENDALL IS GRADUATING AND IT
MEANS A LOT TO ME TO BE ABLE TO SHARE THIS DAY WITH HER. KENDALL
IS OUR FOURTH DAUGHTER TO GRADUATE FROM LEON HIGH SCHOOL.

OVER 95% OF YOU HAVE TAKEN AT LEAST THREE YEARS OF SCIENCE.

YOU'VE HAD TO WORK A LOT HARDER TO FINISH ALL OF THAT. BUT
YOU'RE BETTER PREPARED, BETTER EDUCATED. YOU'VE TESTED YOURSELVES
IN MORE IMPORTANT WAYS THAN JUST FINAL EXAMS.

YOU'VE PROVEN YOU'RE NOT AFRAID TO MEET CHALLENGES -- AND YOU'VE PROVEN YOU CAN HANDLE SUCCESS.
